# 18<sup>th</sup> Plenary Meeting of the European Lifelong Guidance Policy Network 28-29 September 2015, Luxemburg

Dear Sir, Dear Madam,

As the Co-ordinator of the European Lifelong Guidance Policy Network (ELGPN), I have the pleasure to invite you to the 18<sup>th</sup> ELGPN Plenary Meeting to be held in Luxemburg on **28-29 September 2015**. The meeting is jointly organised by the Luxembourg Presidency and the European Commission.

Following the Plenary Meeting, the ELGPN Steering Group (IT, LV, LU, NL and FI) will have a meeting on the subsequent action points on 29 September 2015 (14:00-15:00)

The meeting will take place at the **Chambre de Commerce** (please see the attached practical information document). The draft meeting agenda can be found at the end of this invitation.

The Plenary Meeting will discuss the implementation and dissemination of the Guidelines for Policies and Systems Development for Lifelong Guidance. Time will also be allocated for discussions on future systemic European co-operation in Lifelong Guidance policy development. **The meeting papers**, including a Briefing Note with more detailed working instructions, **will be sent to the delegates by 14 September 2015.** The social programme includes a welcome dinner at Parc Hotel Alvisse on Sunday 27 September, a visit to the MUDAM (Musée d'Art Moderne Grand-Duc Jean) and an official Plenary Meeting dinner at Château Bourglinster on 28 September 2015.

The working assumption is that national delegations consist of designated ELGPN national representatives or have the mandate from their respective ministries. Travel expenses of two designated delegates from each member country have been included in the ELGPN budget on the basis of an economy class ticket. This is to cover travel and subsistence for the meeting. The national ELGPN co-beneficiary and the delegates agree how the travel expenses are reimbursed within the national ELGPN budget. Lunches and dinners during the meeting are included in the ELGPN meeting budget.

You are expected to make your own travel arrangements. Travel and subsistence costs of designated representatives of ELGPN partner organisations (EAIE/Fedora, IAEVG, ICCDPP, PES Network, and EU social partners) will be reimbursed by the Co-ordination Unit following national regulations of the co-ordinating organisation, the University of Jyväskylä.
